Some Prowords

ALL AFTER - all that which follows

ALL BEFORE - all that which proceeds

BREAK - Indicates the separation of the text from other portions of the message

COUNT - Number of words and number groups in the message

CORRECT - You are correct or what you have transmitted is correct

FIGURES - Numerals

FROM - The originator of this message

I SAY AGAIN - I am repeating transmission or portion indicated

I SPELL - I spell the next word phonetically

MESSAGE - The text of the message follows

MORE TO FOLLOW - Transmitting station has additional traffic for the receiving station

OUT - End of my transmission to you and no answer is required or expected.

OVER - End of my transmission to you and a response is expected

ROGER - I have received your last transmission satisfactorily

SAY AGAIN - Repeat your last transmission.

SPEAK SLOWER - Your transmission is at too fast a speed. Reduce speed of transmission

TIME - Time of Message transmission

TO - The addressee

WAIT - I must pause for a few seconds.

WILCO - I have received your signal, understand it, and will comply. (<u>To be used only by the addressee</u>. Since the meaning of ROGER is included in that of WILCO, the two prowords should not be used together.
